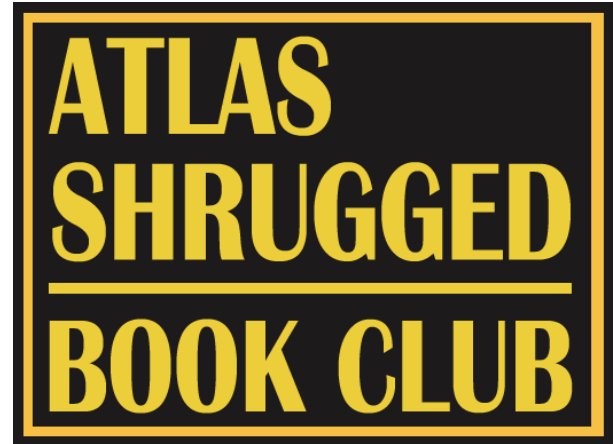

"Atlas Shrugged" was written as a popular novel and published by Random House in 1957. It is second in sales only to the bible.

Most remarkable about a novel in print for 50 years is the increasingly strong trend in sales over recent years.

Paperback sales by New American Library to the book trade averaged 77,600 copies a year in the 1980s, 95,200 copies a year in the 1990s, and in the current decade have averaged 166,003 a year.

After 50 years, annual sales are reaching all-time highs. In 2009, annual sales reached an all-time high of 520,000 copies.
